### Here are the following dates/information:

- *Wednesday, June 3*-Last packet will be mailed

- *Tuesday, June 2, 9 and 16* from 8 a.m.-noon or by appointment-Medication pick-up from Ms. Talham, our nurse.

- We will be notifying families of incoming kindergarten student placements after they are screened and registered in August. State guidelines continue to delay our process.
- Incoming UPK and incoming K parents can register by completing the necessary paperwork online and submit this to our Registrar's Office at MJT.

**Collection of Items/Parade Information:** MJT has chosen a way to honor our students and return your child's belongings at the same time in a drive-through manner. You will pull up to the front of MJT in the bus port and we will deliver your items with a proper send-off. You will remain in your vehicles during this process.
